

## **New Sewer Project to Begin on Sandhill Road and Greenbriar Townhouse Way**

The Clark County Water Reclamation District (District) will be starting a sewer rehabilitation project on Sandhill Road and Greenbriar Townhouse Way. 2,000 feet of new pipeline and 14 new manholes will be installed.

### **TRAVEL ADVISORY**

**Dates: Through at least February 29, 2012**

**Streets: Travel lanes on Sandhill Road at Greenbriar Townhouse Way will be impacted, and Greenbriar Townhouse Way will have a half street closure while crews work to install new sewer line, manholes, a bypass sewer system, and remove existing infrastructure.**

**No parking will be allowed along Greenbriar Townhouse Way.**

**Work will take place from 6:30 a.m. through 3:00 p.m. However, lane restrictions will remain in place 24 hours a day to protect trenches and the bypass sewer lines.**

While work is taking place, drivers should be aware of potential delays, take precautions, and allow extra time when traveling through the impacted area.
