

Sewer Work Begins on Katie Avenue and Maryland Parkway

The Clark County Water Reclamation District (District) is starting sewer rehabilitation work at Katie Avenue east of Maryland Parkway. A new sewer line will be installed, with new manholes and a water line will be relocated.

TRAVEL ADVISORY

Dates: Week of September 23, 2011 through at least November 11, 2011

Streets: Two lanes on Katie Avenue will be restricted from Cambridge to Algonquin Drive. Travel lanes will shift to accommodate both east and west bound travel on Katie Avenue.

Northbound travel on Maryland Parkway may be restricted to allow construction access to Katie Avenue.

Work will be conducted Monday through Friday, 6:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. However, traffic restrictions will remain in place to protect sewer bypass pumps and pipes. Access to businesses in the area will be maintained throughout the project, and the sidewalks and crosswalks will remain open for pedestrian access. Sewer service will not be disrupted.

While work is taking place, drivers should be aware of potential delays, take precautions, and allow extra time when traveling through the impacted area. It services the unincorporated portions of Clark County, within the Las Vegas Valley, as well as the communities of Blue Diamond, Indian Springs, Laughlin, Moapa Valley and Searchlight. The District collects and treats nearly 100 million gallons of wastewater each day utilizing more than 2,000 miles of pipeline and seven treatment facilities.
